

Monday, December 11, 2006 - Public Hearing Information

Open up a public hearing to address any questions regarding the Darien Park District's proposed 2007 Tax Levy Ordinance.

Once questions have been answered, public hearing needs to be closed.

Then to pass the levy ordinance:

A MOTION TO ADOPT THE DARIEN PARK DISTRICT LEVY ORDINANCE #2006-07-04: AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING TAXES FOR THE DARIEN PARK DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2007 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2008.

Some notes:

- The Darien Park District has complied with the qualifications of the Truth in Taxation Act.
 - The District determined at the Monday, November 13th meeting that the District would levy at the 20% new growth rate, which is equivalent to a 21% increase in operating funds and a 26% decrease in debt service; a combined total decrease in property taxes of 2%.
 - The district is levying at this high amount in order to capture all new growth in the community.
 - On Wednesday, November 30th, the required Notice of Public Hearing & the Truth in Taxation were published in the Suburban Life. Please note that the Truth in Taxation has a typo on it - the last line - the total amount of property taxes to be levied for 2005 should be \$2,410,629, not \$2,415,046.
 - Once passed, the Tax Levy Ordinance will be filed as required at the Dupage County Clerk's office before December 27th.
