

PAVILION RENTALS

We ask that everyone who visits our facilities completes this [Health Self-Check Questionnaire](#) before arriving, and only comes to our facilities if you check no to all questions.

The guidelines provided by the [Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity \(DCEO\)](#) for [Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan](#) allow the District to provide pavilion usage for groups of up to 50 people or 50% of capacity, whichever is less. Pavilions are available for public use on a first-come, first-served basis with a permit only. Please note that visitors should sanitize tables, benches and other surfaces before and after use. Outdoor recreation guidelines provided by the [Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity \(DCEO\)](#) for [Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan](#) are listed below.

- Visitors should adhere to minimum safety guidelines during their visit to our parks:
- Maintain social distance of 6 feet from individuals outside of your household
- Group sizes should be limited to 50 individuals or 50% of capacity, whichever is less
 - Community Park North Pavilion 36
 - Community Park South Pavilion 50
 - Meyer Woods Pavilion 42
 - Smart Oaks Pavilion 45
- 30 feet of distance should be maintained between groups
- Wear a face covering if social distancing is not possible
- Sanitize surfaces such as picnic tables and park benches before and after use
- Wash hands often or use hand sanitizer
- Stay home if you are sick

Please note, information is subject to change daily as additional guidelines become available during Phase 4.
