



Family Dog Class

Note: The first class is Orientation. Please do not bring your dog to the first day. Bring your dog's current vaccination records to the first day. Current vaccinations are required. Each dog must be accompanied by at least one adult handler. **NO AGGRESSIVE DOGS!!**

Once your dog enters adolescence and advances into maturity, it is important to make sure they are reliable. You will be given the tools to train your dog how to be reliable when responding to your basic commands. As your dog advances with age, new behaviors may arise that are making it difficult for your dog to be responsive to you and behave appropriately with both humans and animals. You will be given techniques to address the problem behaviors head-on based on your dog's personality and temperament.

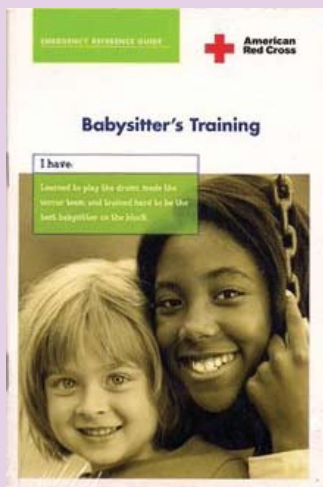
