

DARIEN PARK DISTRICT ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-2023-01

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE BUDGET AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS OF SUMS OF MONEY FOR ALL THE NECESSARY EXPENDITURES OF THE DARIEN PARK DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2022 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Darien Park District, DuPage County, Illinois caused to be prepared in tentative form a budget, and the Secretary of the Board has made the same conveniently available to public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held as to such a budget on the 11th day of April, 2022, notice of said hearing having been given at least one (1) week prior thereto as required by law and all their legal requirements having been complied with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Darien Park District, as follows:

Section 1. That the fiscal year of this District be and the same hereby is fixed and declared to be from May 1, 2022 to April 30, 2023.

That the following budget, containing an estimate of the amount available and expenditures and the appropriation contained therein, be and the same is hereby adopted as the Budget and Appropriations for this Park District for the said fiscal year, and the following sums of money;

- That all unexpended balances from annual appropriations of previous years are hereby re-appropriated for the same general purposes for which they were originally made and may be expended in making up any insufficiency of any other items provided in this appropriation ordinance, in making this appropriation in accordance with applicable law.
- Section 5. That should any clause, sentence, paragraph or a part of the Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.
- Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approved, as required by law.
